(These items will be shared by all students in a caddy for their table group)

- 2 red correcting pens
- #2 pencils, already sharpened NO MECHANICAL PENCILS
- 4 erasers
- 6 glue sticks (any kind)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's Glue, NO gel type

(Items listed below are personal and should have your child's name clearly written on each item)

- Laptop (<u>NOT</u> iPad or tablet) to be used in class daily. Laptop must have the following programs loaded: Web Browser (i.e., Safari, Internet Explorer or Google Chrome), Word Processing (i.e. Word or Pages), and a Slide Presentation (i.e. Keynote or PowerPoint). Other applications may be required by the class teacher, including programs that are available for free and some that may cost a nominal amount
- 1 Ruler
- 1 Clip board
- zip-all pouch to keep all your personal supplies (Make sure your name is on the zip-all)
- 1 small pair of scissors
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 counts)
- 1 box of washable markers (10 count, any kind)
- folders that <u>can be put into the 3-ring binder</u> (double pockets at the bottom) clearly marked "Take Home", "Unfinished Work", "Project and Reports", "Homework", and "Writing"
- single subject 8 1/2 X 11 spiral notebook, wide rule one marked "Core Novels", "Math", "English /Writing"
- 3 ring binder to keep all folders and daily agenda inside
- backpack- medium size --- 10" X 15" x 23" (it must fit inside the closet cubby!)
- 2 reams of copy paper (any kind)
- 1 package of construction paper (asstd. colors)
- 2 Booksox every textbook must be covered with a Booksox
- 2 tubs of 80 count or more wet wipes with dispenser NO travel size (any brand)

STUDENT EARTHQUAKE COMFORT KIT

- Note from parents expressing love and hope
- A favorite small toy or tiny stuffed animal (Small Beany Baby size)
- Paper or small coloring pages, or activity/puzzle booklets, or playing cards
- Colored pencils and sharpener
- Clean underwear and socks
- Small travel size toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush or comb
- If necessary, extra eye glasses (for those with prescriptions)
- Sunglasses
- Small cap or visor
- Barrettes, scrunchies, or other hair tie-backs for girls
- Favorite granola bar, hard candy, or gum (nothing that will melt)

Bags must be able to be zipped close. Please <u>do not over stuff</u> them. All comfort kits will be returned to parents at the end of the school year.
